Marlborough Reserve Pinot Noir 2013



An attractive aroma with violet, plum and cherry along with subtle oak.
The palate is soft, with sweet fruit and gentle tannins.

Winemaking:

The grapes for this wine come from our 'Bottom Terrace' site of our Kuranui vineyard located in the upper reaches of the Awaterre Valley of Marlborough. This small terrace is north facing and naturally protected from the southerly winds.

The site is only able to be hand picked and due to its northerly aspect is an early ripener. Fermentation took place in hand plunged open fermenters in Marlborough, before the young wine was transferred to Hawkes Bay for barrel maturation.

New and used French oak was used for 15 month ageing.
The wine was bottled 4th September 2014
