This Regent of Tantallon is a testament to The Wine Portfolio's ability and desire to offer super premium red wine that is in peak form. Long term aging under anaerobic conditions at critically controlled temperatures has created a wine that shows aromatic complexity combined with the body and silkiness that can only come with careful cellaring.

This barrel aged wine shows a rich bouquet of coffee, leather, black olive and an underlying smokiness. The palate is soft yet supple and the long finish has multiple layers of dark fruits.

Winemaking:

Fruit for this wine came mainly from our Tantallon vineyard in Hawkes Bay. The blend is predominantly Merlot and Cabernet sauvignon with small components of other red varieties.

Following harvest the various parcels of fruit were crushed and fermented at our Riverview winery. The wine was pressed off to barrels for malolactic fermentation and aging in oak. After 36 months in barrel, the wine was transferred to our Katikati winery for further aging. Final bottling was in July 2015.
